INTRODUCTION

This subject index covers the documents and debates of the General Synod of the Church of England during the period November 2006 to July 2009. It lists all the papers issued by the Synod during that period, and with some exceptions indexes the official *Report of Proceedings* covering the period. Items which are not indexed are:

- Questions
- Formal items and procedural business
- Items relating to individuals
- Notice of progress of Measures and Canons

It should be noted that Questions form a substantial section of each *Report of Proceedings* and may contain important information on many subjects.

In the main classified subject index, each subject heading lists all the relevant documents as well as page references to the *Report of Proceedings* for the relevant debates. Items are listed in alphabetical, not chronological, order, and words such as 'A', 'An' and 'The' are ignored in the alphabetical order. The classification used is listed on pages 6-8.

There is also a complete list, in three parts, of General Synod papers issued during the five years, and detailed subject index to the main classified listing.
