

Organise your social media posts in 2020 with our downloadable content calendar

Creating a content calendar needn't be hard, or take up much time, we've even created one for you to download and start using today!

Five steps to get started

- 1. Create a calendar, or better, download our calendar below!
- 2. Start by looking at your planned events and services for the next three months and write these on the calendar, think about how far in advance you'll want to post about each.
- 3. Next, take a look at a seasonal calendar and jot down important dates to include.
- 4. For each date on the calendar, jot down one or two ideas for posts. Remember, you don't have to create each post yourself; instead, find content from other accounts you could share.
- 5. Make a note of which ideas you could ask someone else to help with, and which you'll create yourself.

Once complete, put your calendar somewhere visible where you can keep referring back to!
