INTRODUCTION

This work is a classified subject index to the documents and debates of the General Synod of the Church of England from November 1970 to July 1975 - the life-time of the first Synod.

The subject index lists under each heading all relevant documents received by Synod members, and precise references to debates on that subject as recorded in the official Proceedings. This includes debates on motions not related to any particular document. The following categories of business have not been indexed:

questions	notices of progress of Measures
formal items	formal extensions of periods of
procedural items	approval for experimental
items relating to	services
individuals	annual reports formally approved

The annual index to the Proceedings will be found useful for some of the above categories, and as a different grouping of the material.

In some cases useful material on a particular subject will be found in a general debate - e.g. during discussion on the annual Votes - and this index does not attempt to cover such material except in particular cases where it seems desirable.

All documents of the Synod will be found listed in Appendices I, II and III.

Attention is particularly drawn to the "Suggestions for use" on the following page: they are intended to help both in the full use of this index and in the practical arrangement of files of the documents and the Proceedings.

The subject classification used in this index is set out on the next two pages. A short time spent studying this will be useful in showing the overall arrangement of subjects and how they are related.

Specific subjects will quickly be found by using the detailed alphabetical index on pages 63-68. It can be assumed that any subject not listed there is not dealt with at any length in either the documents or the Proceedings (subject to the limitations of coverage as listed in the Introduction).

Under each subject heading in the main sequence cross-references and added entries are used to draw attention to material listed under other headings. Thus so far as is possible each section is self-contained.

If the entry for a particular document (and the debates arising from it) is required reference to the document in the numerical lists of Synod documents in Appendices I-III will show under which heading it will be found.

It is suggested that this index be used as the basis for arranging those papers which are being kept for reference. They can be marked with the appropriate subject symbol and then kept in subject order. Reference to volumes of the Proceedings is facilitated if the page numbers for each volume are written on the spine.

This index can also be used to arrange papers of the 1975-1980 Synod. Reference to the classification on the next two pages, or to the index at the back in cases of doubt, will nearly always enable the appropriate subject symbol to be chosen and used to file the papers.
