

INTRODUCTION

This work is an index to the documents and debates of the General Synod of the Church of England covering the period July 1990 to July 1995. It lists and indexes all the official papers of the Synod which were issued during that period and (with the exceptions noted below) indexes the official Report of Proceedings covering the period. The index is in three parts:

A CLASSIFIED SUBJECT INDEX (beginning on page 1).

Under each subject heading are listed all the relevant documents and page references to the Proceedings for the related debates. Extensive cross-references are given to ensure that all relevant material is listed under each subject heading. The subject classification used is set out on pages vi-vii. Except for a few headings it is identical with that used for the earlier indices.

A LIST OF GENERAL SYNOD PUBLICATIONS (beginning on page 49)

This is a complete list, in three parts, of the official documents and papers issued during the five years.

A GENERAL INDEX (beginning on page 63).

This is a very full subject index to all the entries in the main sequence. Subject to the limitations of coverage listed below it can be assumed that a subject not listed was not dealt with at any length during the five years.

The following have not been included in the index:

- formal items and procedural business
- items relating to individuals
- notices of progress of Measures and Canons

Of these, it should be noted that 'Questions' form a substantial section in each volume of the Proceedings and contain important material on many subjects.

Each entry in the main sequence consists a listing of one or more documents (or the name of a subject) followed by a listing of the relevant debate(s) in the Proceedings.

The references to the debates give the year and the page numbers. One volume of the Proceedings is issued for each group of Sessions, with the pages numbered consecutively through the calendar year.
