- Insight into some of the challenges involved with researching church growth.

- A chance to discuss and debate the findings: including their relevance to your situation.
- An honest assessment of what we still do not know and of where we might go from here.



LONDON UNDERGROUND

- Russell Square Underground Station on the Piccadilly Line, direct to Heathrow Airport in fifty minutes, is one minute away.
- Holborn Underground on the Central Line is seven minutes walking distance.

BRITISH RAIL MAINLINE STATIONS

BUSES

• A taxi cab rank is situated directly opposite the Hotel, on Russell Square.
