## Survey of ethnic make-up of Church of England Clergy

Since 2000 the General Synod has debated a number of reports that have challenged the Church to identify and address racism in its own life and promote greater ethnic and cultural diversity. These reports were prepared in response to the findings of the public inquiry into the death of Stephen Lawrence. In July 2003 the General Synod accepted the recommendations of the report *Called to Act Justly*. One of these proposed that there should be an audit of the clergy to establish the proportion that are from minority ethnic backgrounds and the offices that they hold, with special reference to gender and country of birth. The information will be used to assess how far the Church's ministry reflects the ethnic diversity of the country and capacity to relate to a multiethnic society and any strategies that need to be developed.

On the back of this letter is a questionnaire, based on that used in the national census. I urge you to complete it. The information that you give will be seen only by the data processors and relevant staff of the National Church Institutions and will be held on a confidential record linked to the Crockford database. No individual details will be published but the information will be used to derive statistics aggregated to diocesan or national level. Information about future clergy will be added to the database when they join the Church of England's ministry.

The questionnaire also includes a question on disability. Again it is hoped that greater understanding will lead to better inclusion and valuing of people's abilities.

It would be helpful if you could return the questionnaire in the enclosed envelope as soon as possible but no later than **Friday 24 June 2005.**
