It is also a good idea to follow these processes if even you are not required to, as it ensures that you know you are getting good value for money.

The process to procure goods, and to recruit consultants and contractors must be fair and open.

Buying goods, works and services using public money

You have to tender for services by a professional adviser if your project is funded by more than 50% of public money, even if your project is divided into stages over several years.

Public funds include:

- Listed Places of Worship Grant Scheme
- National Lottery Heritage Fund grants
- Any other public-sector grants

Procurement stages

Procurement involves five main stages:

- 1. Scoping : understanding the needs of the work
- 2. Scoping people: understanding why you require certain types of people and skills
- 3. Shortlisting: inviting a short list of people or companies with the required skills
- 4. Tendering: People or companies offering evidence of their efficiency to complete the work
- 5. Contracting: awarding the contract to the best tender

What should you look for in a quote?

The tendering process is not just about the price.

You should also look for:

• Quality of the proposal or service

• Experience, qualifications and resources of the professional adviser

• Communication skills

• And an understanding of your needs

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This means that if the current church architect is the best person to do the work, according to reasonable and clear criteria, then you can award them the contract, even if their costs are a little higher than those of a less suitable candidate.

2. Work needed:

The general scope of works included are:

• Repairing the roof structure and replacing failing lead sheets on the whole of the South Aisle roof plus the stolen lead sheets from the North Porch with terne

coated stainless steel sheets and wood core joints. Repairing other minor roof and rainwater goods defects.

- Lead roof repairs to North Transept and Baptistery.
- Installation of Photo Voltaic panels on the South Aisle roof.
- Repair and conservation of external masonry and the removal of cementitious pointing
- Interventions to improve sustainability and accessibility include the automation of the existing inner West Porch doors

- Installing a sensitive, energy efficient lighting scheme internally, lighting above the west door and illumination of the tower
- Replacing the boiler and associated pipework
- Creating storage in the church

• Specialist glazing repairs – a quotation will be included within the tender documents as the PCC are procuring the specialist subcontractor prior to the tender period.

• Providing full interpretation scheme designed by Specialist. This will not be part of the main contract scope but completed by a specialist subcontractor direct to the Client. The Main Contractor will need to liaise with the interpretation subcontractor regarding programme and site access etc.

Project budget between £2m and £2.2m.
