

Details regarding proposed pastoral reorganisation affecting the benefices of Barton; Carisbrooke; St Nicholas in the Castle, Carisbrooke; Gatcombe; Newport; and Newport St John in the Diocese of Portsmouth.

The proposals provide for the termination of a plurality; the union of benefices and parishes; and the establishment of a team ministry and a new plurality.
