12 But the king shall rejoice in God;

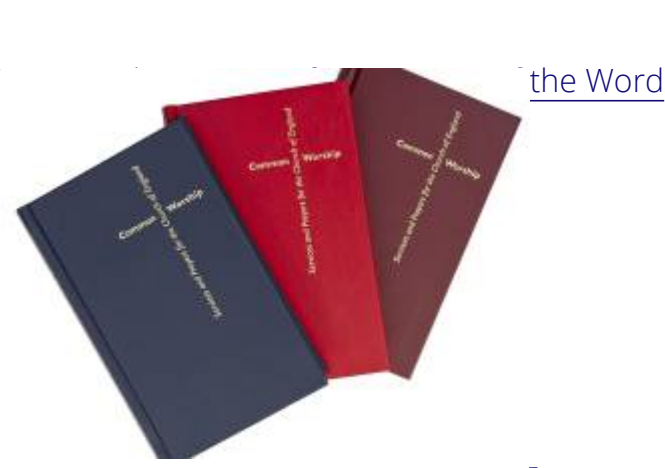
all those who swear by him shall be glad, □
