and has not despised their plea.
19 This shall be written for those that come after, □
and a people yet unborn shall praise the Lord.
20 For he has looked down from his holy height;
from the heavens he beheld the earth,
21 That he might hear the sighings of the prisoner □ —

22 That the name of the Lord may be proclaimed in Zion 🏻	
and his praises in Jerusalem,	
23 When peoples are gathered together	
and kingdoms also, to serve the Lord.	
24 He has brought down my strength in my journey []	
and has shortened my days.	
25 I pray, 'O my God, do not take me in the midst of my days; □	
your years endure throughout all generations.	
26 'In the beginning you laid the foundations of the earth, □	
and the heavens are the work of your hands;	
27 'They shall perish, but you will endure; 🏻	
they all shall wear out like a garment.	
28 You change them like clothing, and they shall be changed;	
but you are the same, and your years will not fail.	
29 'The children of your servants shall continue, 🏻	
and their descendants shall be established in your sight.'
