

Working with Wade Brothers Productions we are producing a high quality nativity film that is accessible to multiple audiences (schools, churches, those new to worship through online engagement, families and children, and social media). Our vision is to create a film that brings everything that people associate with a nativity; fun, silliness, bad costumes, dodgy props and the odd forgotten line here or there - but filmed in a visually interesting way that feels different and cinematic. Acknowledging our current world situation whilst inspiring comfort and joy and hope within chaos. The film will be around 9 mins in length and can be watched as a whole or in two episodes.

The film will come with a suite of accompanying resources:

- 2 collective worship plans for classroom bubbles (using the 2 episodes) + take home activities
- A family and children's worship, craft and activity session
- An all age church service format (for worship in the building or online)
- Prayer resources
- A discussion session for those new to church through online worship

The film and resources will be ready by the middle of November, and as we have done previously, we will make these resources widely available for free use.
