

If you need experienced support and advice to help with establishing a new kind of church congregation, Greenhouse facilitators may be able to help.

Greenhouse facilitators help Greenhouse teams gather together twice a year so they can share wisdom and learning with each other. In doing this, they support the teams with moving on to the next stage of the [Listening First Missional Journey](#) from whatever stage they are currently at.

They often have a role in the diocesan office, such as a Mission Enabler or Mission Adviser, but not always.

If you'd like to have a conversation with the Greenhouse Facilitator nearest to you, we can put you in touch with them.
