THE CHURCH OF ENGLAND

St Michael's, Baddesley Clinton (Diocese of Birmingham) has successfully achieved net-zero carbon through a number of recent measures. The small parish church, located in the Diocese of Birmingham, runs entirely on electricity. Recent projects to improve the efficiency of heating and lighting include the conversion to under-pew heating and LED lightbulbs. The effect of this has been a massive reduction in the amount of energy used in the day-to-day functioning of the church.

In further pursuit of net-zero, the team at St Michael's has also calculated travel emissions and offsets them via a scheme which supports community projects worldwide.
