

What is the purpose of the study?

The Church of England has launched a major study to learn about how young people develop lasting relationships with the Church. To achieve this, we are asking parents around the country to tell us about the ways in which their children have connected with churches and the factors which determine this relationship. We also want to learn from young people themselves about what makes them an active member of your congregation (or not any more), what they love (and don't love) about church, how rooted they feel in their faith and where they are going as a young Christian.

Why my church?
