After “GS 2020” in paragraph (c) *insert* “and, recognising the vital contribution of TElS and the importance of their full involvement in developing with dioceses a shared understanding of ministry and ministerial education and in implementing as set out in Annex F of GS 2020 the funding arrangements, request the Archbishops’ Council to report to the Synod by July 2017 on progress towards achieving these objectives”.

CANON C4

The Revd Prebendary Simon Cawdell (Hereford) to move:

That this Synod request the Business Committee to bring forward legislation to amend Canon C 4 so as to repeal paragraphs 3 and 3A relating to those who have previously been remarried following divorce, or who have married spouses whose previous marriage has ended by divorce, and whose former spouse is still living, mindful that paragraph 1 already places upon bishops the obligation to ensure those who are presented for ordination are “of virtuous conversation and good repute and such as to be a wholesome example and pattern to the flock of Christ”.
