‘THEOS’

Field of chaplaincy	Numbers
Sport	>300 (Sports Chaplaincy UK)
Higher Education	883 in 2008 (now estimated to be significantly higher)
Schools	170 known to Church of England. >2000 Roman Catholic schools of whom majority are thought to have chaplaincy provision
Police	c.650
Hospital	350 full time, estimates for part-time and volunteer numbers range, but at least 3000
Prison	c.1000 (plus over 7000 chaplaincy volunteers)
Military	64 Regular, 7 Reserves (Royal Navy), 152 Regular and c.150 Reserves (Army), 69 (RAF)
Anglicans	1415-14,000(!)

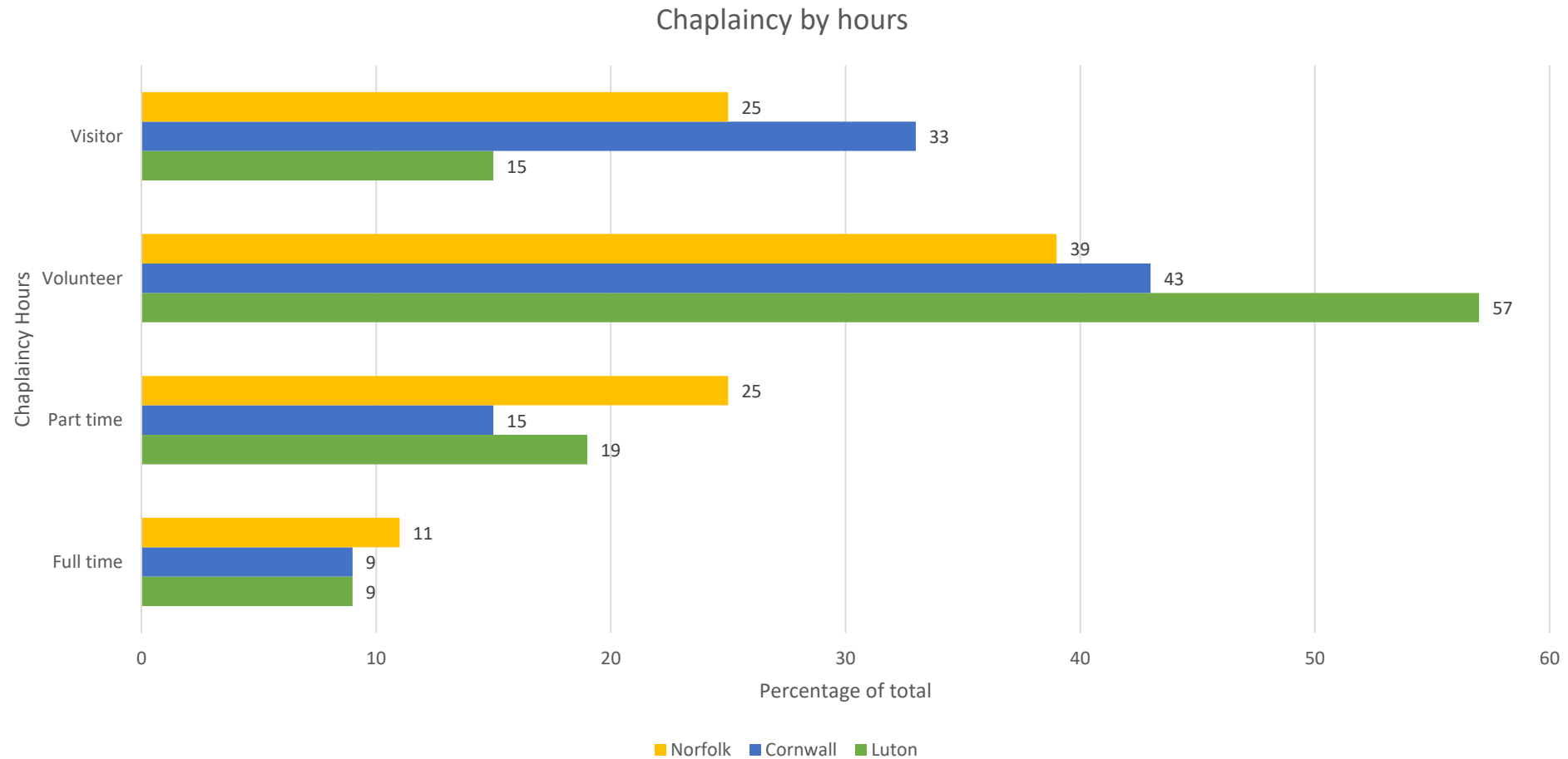
