INTRODUCTION

This work is an index to the documents and debates of the General Synod of the Church of England covering the period July 1980 to July 1985. It lists and indexes all the official papers of the Synod issued or discussed during that period and (with exceptions noted below) indexes the official Report of Proceedings covering the period. The Index is in three parts, as follows.

- (1) The classified subject index, beginning on page 1. Under each subject heading are listed all the relevant documents and page references to the report of debates in the Proceedings. Extensive cross-references have been given so that under each heading all related material will be found listed. The subject classification used in this Index is set out on pages (vi)-(vii)
- (2) The list of General Synod publications, beginning on page. This is a complete list, in three parts, of the official documents and papers issued during the five years and continues the listing in the two previous Indexes covering 1970-1980
- (3) The general index, beginning on page 73. This is a very detailed alphabetical index to the main classified Index. It includes subjects and names. Subject to the limitations of coverage listed below it can be assumed that a subject not listed in the alphabetical index was not dealt with at any length during the five years.

Of these it should be noted that 'Questions' constitute a substantial section of each volume of Proceedings and contain a large amount of information, some of it related to matters which are indexed.

In some cases useful material on a particular subject may be found in a general debate, such as the discussion on the agenda at the beginning of each Group of Sessions, the consideration of the annual votes and the discussions on the annual reports of the board, etc., when these take place. This Index is not able to cover such material.

Under each subject heading all the relevant papers and subjects discussed are listed. Related papers are grouped together. Reference to the resulting consideration in synod is given by year and page details which refer to the volumes of the Report of Proceedings. Three volumes of report are issued each year, one for each Group of Sessions, and the pages are numbered in one sequence for the whole year - it will be found useful to mark on the cover of each volume the page numbers it contains.
