## INTRODUCTION

This work is an index to the documents and debates of the General Synod of the Church of England covering the period July 1985 to July 1990. It lists and indexes all the official papers of the Synod which were issued or discussed during that period and (with the exceptions noted below) indexes the official Report of Proceedings covering the period. The Index is in three parts:

A CLASSIFIED SUBJECT INDEX (beginning on page 1) Under each subject heading are listed all the relevant documents and page references to the Proceedings for the related debates. Extensive cross-references have been given so that under each heading all relevant material is listed. The subject classification used is set out on pages (vi-vii). It differs very little from the classification used for earlier Indices.

A LIST OF GENERAL SYNOD PUBLICATIONS (beginning on page 54) This is a complete list, in three parts, of the official documents and papers issued during the five years.

A GENERAL INDEX (beginning on page 67) This is a full alphabetical index to the main classified sequence. Subject to the limitations of coverage listed below it can be assumed that a subject not listed in the alphabetical index was not dealt with at any length during the five years.

The following have not been indexed:

- questions
- formal items
- procedural items
- items relating to individuals
- notices of progress of Measures and Canons
- formal extensions of approval for services

It should be noted that 'Questions' form a substantial section in each volume of the Proceedings and contain much information, often related to matters which have been discussed and are indexed.

Most entries in the Index consist of reference to one document or subject followed by the reference to the relevant debate in the Proceedings. But on some topics a number of documents were issued over a period and the convention followed here is to list all the documents together, followed by the references to the debates on that topic without indication of which particular document(s) a particular debate referred to

References to debates give the year and the relevant page numbers. Three volumes of the Report of Proceedings were issued each year, one for each group of Sessions, and the pages are numbered in one sequence through the year.
