Extensive cross-references are given so that all relevant material is listed under each subject heading. The classification used is set out on pages vi-vii.

A detailed subject index to the main classified arrangement will be found beginning on page 65. Subject to the limitations of coverage mentioned above it can be assumed that a subject not listed was not dealt with during the five years.
