NOTICE OF MOTIONS, AMENDMENTS AND QUESTIONS

Save where a special note is included in the Agenda the following rules apply under the Standing Orders of the General Synod to notice of motions and amendments other than procedural motions:

- 1. The period of notice of new business has expired, save for urgent or other specially important business included by the direction of the Presidents.
- 2. Notice of motions and amendments arising out of business on the Agenda (other than amendments to legislative business) must be delivered to the Clerk to the Synod as follows (Standing Orders 10(a), 11 and 26(a)):

Business appointed for the *first day of the group of sessions* (23 November) – **5.30 p.m. on 22 November**

Business appointed for the second day of the group of sessions (24 November):

Business appointed for the morning sitting – **10 a.m. on 23 November**:

- 3. Under Standing Orders 10(a) and 26(a), such notice must be accompanied by evidence of support from two or more members of the Synod in addition to the member giving the notice. (This provision does *not* apply to amendments to legislative business.)
- 4. Notice of amendments to legislative business must be given in accordance with the notes accompanying the relevant item in this Agenda. Please note in particular that notice of amendments to item 504 (Draft Act of Synod Adopting the Anglican Communion Covenant (GS 1809)), or of other business arising out of it, must be given by 4 p.m. on Tuesday 23 November 2010.
- 5. An amendment of which due notice has not been given may only be moved by permission of the Chair (SO 26(b)).
- 6. Notice of Questions under Standing Orders 105-106 must be delivered not later than 5.30 p.m. on Thursday 11 November 2010 (SO 10(b)(i)), with an indication of whether an oral or written answer is required (SO 105(c)). Unless notice is given that an oral answer is required, it will be assumed that a written answer is required.
- 7. Notice must be in writing, signed by the member giving notice and delivered to the Clerk to the Synod either by hand, by post, fax or e-mail.
