# Some encouragements within confirmations, informal learning and self-reproducing dynamics

## Discipleship: What is working?

Discipling methods	All MES	FxC MES	Outreach MES
Adults serving in teams	32%	43%	21%
One-to-one	31%	47%	15%
Small groups	29%	36%	22%
Children/teens serving in teams	28%	33%	23%

"Anyone can be a Messy Church leader... that can be a medium through which you grow into a better, deeper relationship with God."

"It waxes and wanes like a lot of these things... none of our journeys are a trajectory in one direction, let's be honest... particularly when you're further back."

## Discipleship: What needs more work?

#### Being more intentional about discipleship

"It's important that we don't use churchy language...
it's very easy to slip into words that we would
understand which mean precious little to the man in
the street"

"You might be very hopeful that they become disciples but we don't - you know, that's not - in our heads."

Discipleship through wider parish	36%	38%	35%

# Follow-up of adults after their children have left Messy Church

Type of youth provision	All MES %
Separate youth group	28%
Serve as helpers	21%
Further group/activities	<b>8</b> %
Changed MES to be youth focused	2%
Confirmation	1%


But...

## Maturity as church: What is working?

Teams are finding patterns that work for them




#### But also:


- Prayer request email groups
- Social media chat groups
- Meal rotas or for families in tough times or babysitting
- Social activities/outings/Christian conferences
- 19% reported further outreach activities

## Maturity as church: What is working?

#### Word and some exploration of Sacrament

Story- telling	96%
Creative activity/ resource	95%
Talk	<b>70</b> %
Take home activity for families	32%
Passages read in public	31%
Memory verses	12%
Encourage individual reading at home	9%
Study in groups	5%





## Maturity as church: What needs more work?

# Understanding the concept of congregational maturity - or vulnerability

"There is [a] sense that if your Messy Church has been going for more than [a couple of years] then you should be thinking about discipleship."

#### Working for maturity?

- Light-touch strategic planning
- Taking responsibility for leadership succession
- Small but subtle ways you communicate you are a congregation
- Pastoral care of families

#### Looking after Messy Church leaders


"People still expect you to clean, do the readings on Sunday, intercessions, etc... [when I haven't even] had the time to be able to go and visit all the Messy families."
