I was there as a local resident and progressional youth worker. Over fifteen years I worked across the community as a Hampshire County Council youth worker at the same time I was an Off The Record vounteer and I worked for a local housing associatiuon. Your vicars were the only ones back then involved in the community, working alongside organisations I worked with. Someone, some people have decided to suggest changes, ideas for these three parishes. They are just that ' some peoples' ideas, that doesnt make them right. Savings benefits to any change should take into account the parisheners feelings. Their good will be priceless. A main purpose of the changes seems to be about getting more money from the church nationally. To do this it would appear the diocese must free up money from its current budget.I think keeping the congregations happy - keeping Father Jonathon and Karina is important. Failure in listening to your congregations could see you lose some of the members. I realised through reading notes prior to the meeting that the three churches parishes have been underfunded for some years.Why do they have to lose to bvery loved, supported Vicars to release more money? This isn't about a business, fancy ideas for re-organisation, its a bout a group of people who share the same religion, a faith. In 1987 ST Frances and the reverand Graeme Knowles were fundamental in establishing the 3-ways project in purbrook way. The revamp of the existing youth club,a new building for Off The Record youth counselling charity and a hosing project for 28 young people. Over the next fifteen years I worked with many great people from your churches. The churches aren't in an affluent area the issues people face are harder. The areas are akin to inner city areas. The Vicars I kinew all these years ago went on to bigger things. One took over ST Marys in Fratton. One became the Bishop of Carlisle then the dean of Westminster. Father Jonathon and Karina have remained loyal to their congregations they love their congregations and in turn are much loved by them. Through the support of your clergy residents have much better outcomes than can be gained by congregations in more affluent areas. After years of Austerity, cuts your clergys help has been invaluable The residents have lost enough and will not have

In strategy it mentions new housing estates, new churches, will this come from selling any of the land current churches are situated on? You have no gaurentees youll get new parisheners from new estates. You do know you have parisheners at current venues. 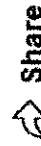
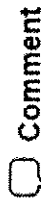
What I want to know is where does the 'Sacredness of Priesthood' come into the diocesan plans?... Clearly it doesn't! The long process the priests have to go through to get where they are today... from saying 'yes' to God (which for some might take months, even years to find the courage to do so!) to accept their vocation calling, to finding the courage to see their vicar and be referred to a Director of Ordinands and Vocation Advisor... From that they go through various interviews, placements, studying and form filling.... and that's just the exploring part!! After all of this, they go to a 'Bishop's Advisory Panel' for three days where they decide if the person has a true calling to priesthood (in their minds!) by meeting the 'Criteria' of the Church of England. They also have to meet with their bishop who is a part of that decision process.... After this if they get the 'yes' they then go to theological college for training and at the end are then ordained as a deacon for a year and sent to a parish church to train and then ordained as a priest the following year. After the 3-4 years in parish training they then go on to their own parish etc and begin Mission in their places of responsibility. This is no easy process!

It's not like the secular world where you go for a job interview one day and start the next... It takes years for these ten priests to be where they are today! I know this personally because I have supported friends through this process and have been through part of it myself twice! Though I had to give up both times for personal reasons and lack of confidence in my capabilities, I made some amazing friends through a group formed online for discernment and have stood by them through the rollercoaster of emotions that are involved in this whole process and are today wonderful priests and we have remained close friends to this day!

So my question to the Portsmouth diocese is... Where in all this Parish reorganisation removal of priest's is the 'Sacredness' of Priesthood?!

Do we know just how cruel and unbalanced new style modern charismatic churches can be? They may get the head count and the money in but I experienced first hand cruel judgemental attitudes from one such church catering mainly for fit young students. Get rid of vicars and you get rid of a lot experience, acceptance and balance that has always been at the heart of being British. The current parish system means that vicars serve the parish in a non judgemental way. One step into a new style charismatic church and their superficial judgements and assumptions about 'where you are with Jesus' are already kicking in. Theologically they readily come off the rails even with their own grace doctrines. I was actually forbidden to pray for people and they emphasised the authority of the elders. The exuberance and desire for simple power structures in the young can turn tribal and self serving, appealing only at a highly emotional level. Please please don't just get rid of vicars, they are our last stand for real acceptance and grace in this country. They may tend to have rather posh backgrounds but they can have a calmer and more balanced view in adversity and trials of life that highly emotional students don't yet have. Also vicars are supervised but too many pastors and elders are unsupervised. Scrap a system recklessly and we lose a wealth of balance and experience. I for one would feel alienated.

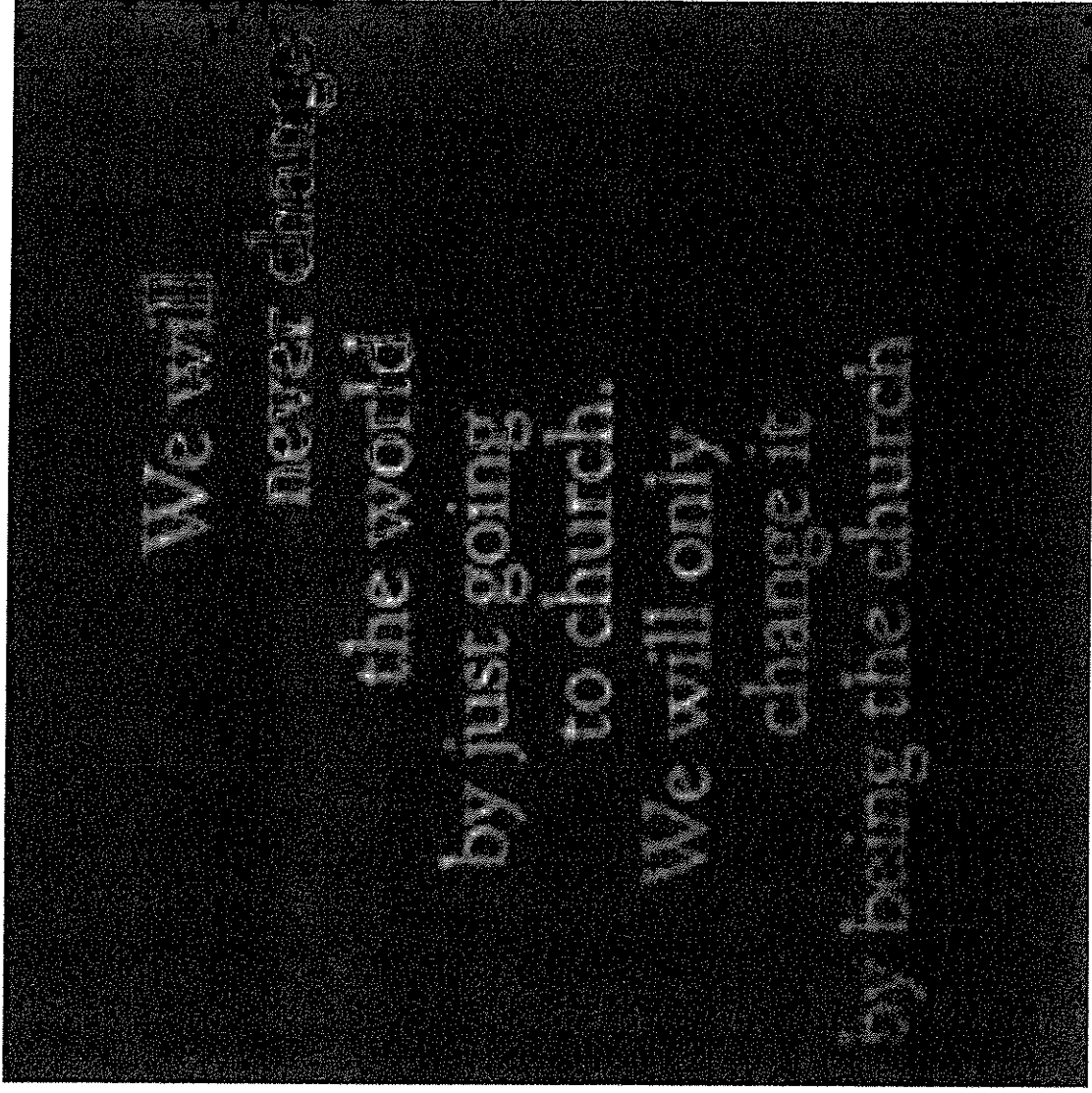

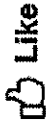
