CHURCH STATISTICS 1976 YEAR BOOK

This section of the 1976 Year Book has been compiled by the Statistics Department of the Central Board of Finance from the Parochial Returns of Membership and Finance for the year 1973, and from information collected from other sources. Except for two tables relating to deacons, clergy statistics are not included because the Statistics Department has relinquished responsibility for the maintenance of the Central Statistical Register of the Clergy.

To enable quick reference to be made to some of the national totals of the detailed diocesan ures for 1973 which appear in Tables VIII-XI, XIII-XV, they are summarised in bles I-V with comparable figures for 1970. Similar diocesan summaries, and extracts of diocesan figures from Table XII have already been sent to diocesan offices.

Membership and Population. When using the membership statistics, due consideration uld be given to a changing population pattern influenced by annual births falling towards he much steadier level of annual deaths, and a continuing loss of population by migration. (See Tables VI, VII.)

Existing church electoral rolls came to an end in 1972 and new rolls were compiled early in 1972 in accordance with the Church Representation Rules attached to the Synodical Government Measure, 1969. Electoral rolls are revised annually.

Parochial Finance. Although the incomes of the parishes showed considerable increases in 1973 compared with 1970, the increases in most dioceses were not sufficient to overcome the effects of inflation in the years 1971–1973. Table XII has been included in this section to indicate the effects of the declining purchasing power of the £ on parochial incomes

2. The last twenty years have fallen into two distinct periods, a decade of increasing followed by a decade of decreasing annual births. Since 1964 annual births fell by an average of 2 per cent each year until 1971, and then sharply declined by about 7 per cent in 1972 and 1973. The nature increase (births less deaths) in 1974 was at an unprecedented level for a peace time year. 5.

3. The fall in the number of births has been the main factor in the diminishing level of the natural increase of the population over the past decade, but a contributory factor has been a slow upward trend over several decades in the number of deaths. This latter feature is reflected in the changing age structure of the population, particularly the increase in the numbers of elderly people as illustrated in Table VII.

The electoral basis was the roll which had to be prepared in each parish and there have been only small changes in the qualifications for entry since that time. The present rule provides that a person may apply for entry if he (i) is baptised; (ii) is a member of the Church of England or another Church of the Anglican Communion or Church in communion with the Church of England; (iii) is seventeen or over, and (iv) is resident in the parish or if not so resident, has habitually attended public worship in the parish during a period of six months prior to enrolment. REVISION Electoral Rolls are revised annually, the names of those no longer qualified being removed and the names of others applying being added. The system is not always effective in establishing a realistic roll as insufficient care may be taken in revision. Another important factor is that any person who is baptised and resident has a right or claim membership of the Church of England and entry on the roll regardless of whether he attends services or otherwise shows interest in Church affairs. The names of persons within this category cannot be removed without their consent. NEW ROLLS The Church Representation Rules attached to the first time existing rolls should come to an end, in the early months of 1972 and thereafter every six years.
