

ORDER BY THE TRIBUNAL CONCERNING THE IDENTITY OF 'Mrs X'

We order that the actual name, and any identifying details of the person described in our Decision as 'Mrs X', must not be published or otherwise made public, being satisfied under rule 49 of the Clergy Discipline Rules 2005 ('the Rules') that this is desirable to protect the private life of 'Mrs X', and any child related to 'Mrs X' and is otherwise in the interests of justice.

Take Notice that if any person does or omits to do anything which is in contempt of this order as certified by the Chair of the Tribunal in accordance with Rule 105 of the Clergy Discipline Measure, the matter may be referred to the High Court under s.81(3) of the Ecclesiastical Jurisdiction Measure 1963 and the person concerned may be sent to prison or fined or both.
