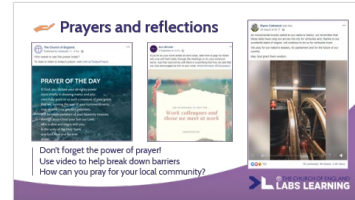

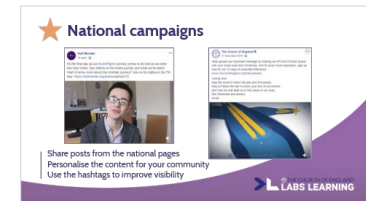

When you ask for forgiveness, for fear to be taken away, the Lord then "removes our sins as far from us as the east is from the west." Psalm 103:12

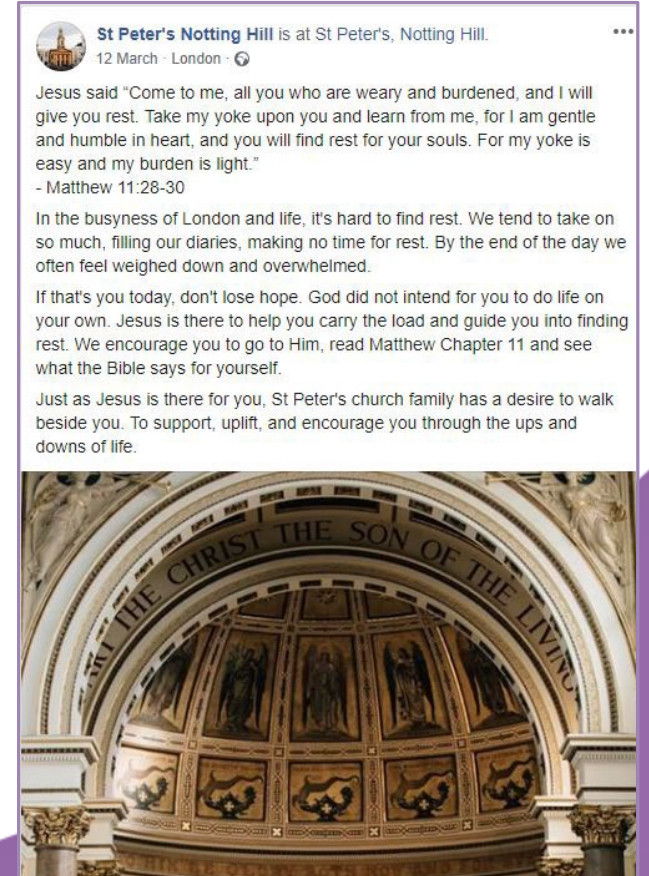
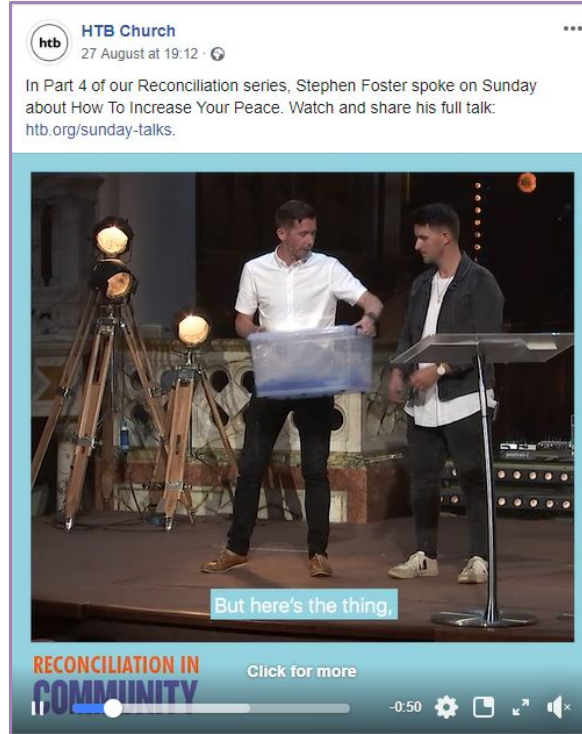
If shame comes into your mind or you negatively criticize yourself for what you've done know that's not Gods heart for you.
