



thechurchofengland Today is #PentecostSunday. Churches across the Church of England celebrate the gift of God's Holy Spirit being given to the disciples after Jesus' ascension, empowering them to begin the work of making disciples of all the nations.

With its focus on God's Spirit being poured out on believers, Pentecost is one of the most popular days for baptisms and confirmations in the Church's year.

Pentecost also marks the end of #ThyKingdomCome, 11 days of prayer across the Church for more people to get to know Jesus.
