

# Will Clause Wording

## A Charitable Gift to the Pensions Board

### To leave a share of your estate:

"I give all / \_\_\_\_\_ % of the residue of my real and personal property whatsoever and wheresoever situate (including any property over which I may have a general power of appointment or disposition by will) to my (executors / trustees) for the payment of my debts funeral and testamentary expenses legacies all duties and taxes estate free of all taxes on any legacy gift devise or annuity given free of duty or tax and subject thereto the General Purposes Fund of the Church of England Pensions Board of 29 Great Smith Street, Westminster, LONDON SW1P 3PS (registered charity no. 236627) as constituted under the Church of England Pensions Measures 1961-2003 or any statutory amendment or re-enactment of the same and I declare that a receipt signed by the Secretary or other proper officer of the said Board shall be a full and sufficient receipt and discharge for the same.

### To leave a fixed sum of money:

"I give the sum of £ \_\_\_\_\_ ( \_\_\_\_\_ pounds only) free of all taxes to the General Purposes Fund of the Church of England Pensions Board of 29 Great Smith Street, Westminster, LONDON SW1P 3PS (registered charity no. 236627) as constituted by the Church of England Pensions Measures 1961-2003 or any statutory amendment or re-enactment of the same and I declare that the receipt signed by the Secretary or other proper officer of the said Board shall be a full and sufficient receipt and discharge for the same.

## To leave a gift of property:

"I give my freehold / leasehold property known as \_\_\_\_\_

Smith Street, Westminster, LONDON SW1P 3PS (registered charity no. 236627) as  
constituted under the Church of England Pensions Measures 1961-2003 or any statutory  
amendment or re-enactment of the same. The said Board shall hold the said property  
upon trust for use as a home for retired clergy of the Church of England and their  
spouses or for the widows and widowers and dependants of deceased clergy or for  
retired licensed lay workers of the Church of England and their spouses or for the  
widows and widowers and dependants of deceased licensed lay workers but with the  
power to sell the same and to apply the proceeds in the provision of another home or  
homes for such persons or to apply the proceeds in relieving any such persons who are  
in conditions of need, hardship or distress.
