


#### Remember to be sociable on social media


- Social media is a place where communities gather and have fun

- Invite your community to share what is at the heart of Christmas for them








## Reach into your local community using social media

- Make it easy for your community to share and invite
- Decorate your social media pages and website using the free downloads
- Create Facebook events, as well as listing events on your website to make it easy to share
- Share your events into local Facebook Groups, Next Door, and local WhatsApp groups
- Add **locations** to *all* your posts (Check-In on Facebook)
- Use local hashtags #Norwich #Norfolk #Norwichliving (on Instagram and Twitter)
- Talk about your local community on your website help your page to appear in local Google searches









### Tips for using social media more effectively

- Publish all your videos and images directly on Facebook
- Respond to your comments and messages
- Post when your community are most likely online 7am / 8pm
- Post regularly
- Try a variety of content types video, images, questions, polls



### Involve your community

- Ask your community to share their pictures and videos
- Use polls and questions
- Ask your community to **vote** on carols or items for Christmas services
- Ask community members to share what Christmas means to them by replying as a comment, recording a video, or writing a post
- Use **different presenters** to record prayers, readings and reflections
