WHY ARE WE MEETING?

Colleagues have asked for a network which provides the following:

- Knowledge help to develop a secure understanding of **Growing Faith**
- Research opportunities to engage in research together and discuss it in the light of our work
- Sharing opportunities to connect and share between parachurch organisations
- Diocesan links access to dioceses and key stakeholders in the Church of England
- Critical reflection and challenge opportunities to work together, to collaborate and to shape each other's work.



Wayne Dixon (Christian Connections in Schools) led us in prayer, thanking God for the opportunities we have to connect and serve together, and for the gift of collaboration. Wayne is a member of the network, and is involved in the emerging work around Serving The Local School.

"Parents and churches believe there should be a partnership - this is a positive thing!"

"This research highlights a disconnect between parents and church leaders which is stronger than we are comfortable with."

"Expectations around Sundays and behaviour come through...this is something which needs culture change".

"Parents and carers are the resource! We need to invest in them!"

"Worksheets were a great way to facilitate doorstep contact during the pandemic, which was important parents clearly appreciate relationship above all else. But in and of themselves, they did not come out as useful. How might our resources support parents in their role?"

"Relationship is so key when thinking about children who have experienced trauma. These children may not remember the detail of what they're taught in church, but they will definitely remember how they are made to feel, and this will affect whether or not they return."

"What's the shared vision? How do we release kids into faith? What structure do we have that enables? How do we create a culture where faith can flourish?"

We need to look afresh at what we do and why."
