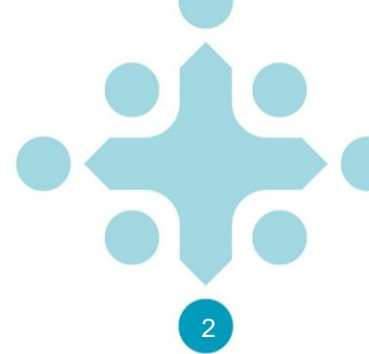




Progress to date

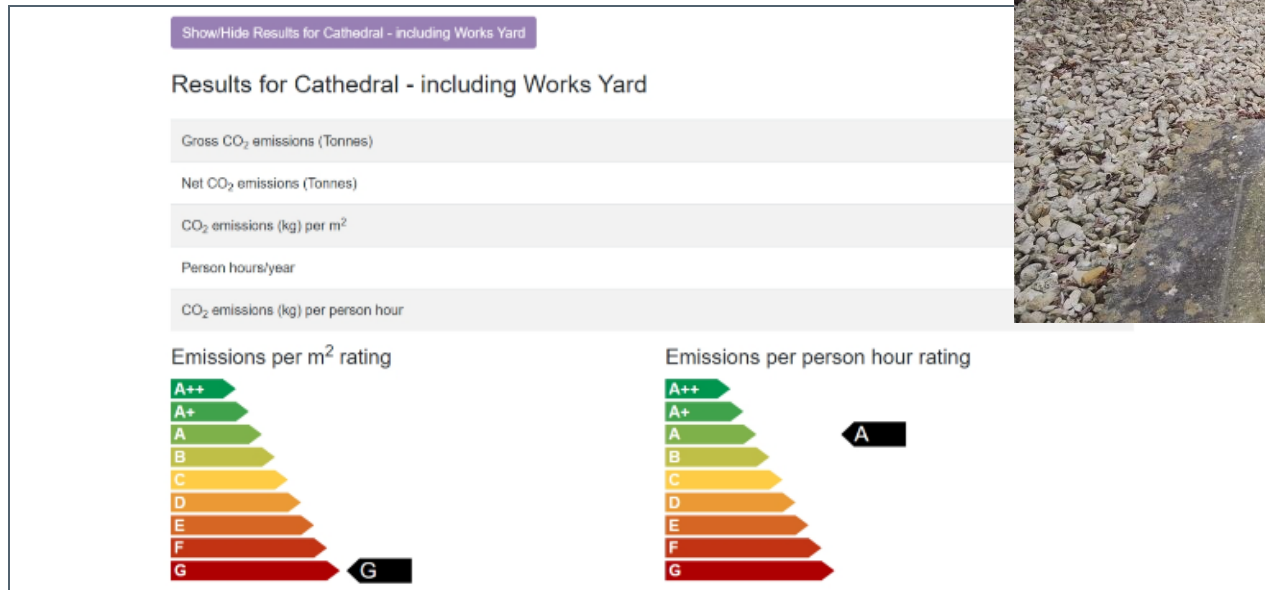
- ❖ Solar panels (2019)

 - Green tariff electricity – Parish Buying

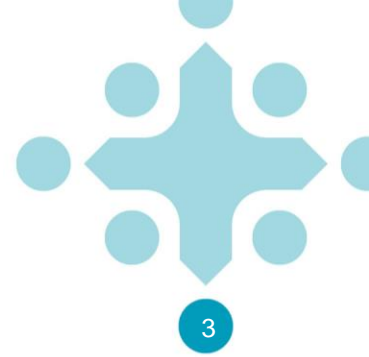

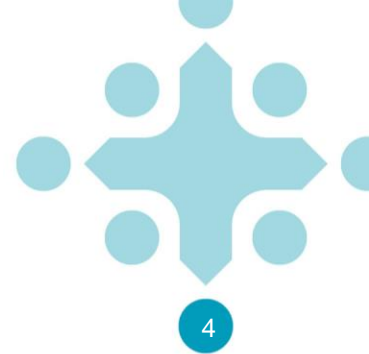
- ❖ LED relamping begun (2022)
