Meet one of the Growing Faith research projects - and be happy!




St Andrew's Church & School Happiness Club is one of the Growing Faith Foundation's funded research projects, exploring intergenerational school/church connections in Kettering, Northamptonshire. A cohort of primary school pupils and older church members explore Action for Happiness's *Keys for happier living*. The six sessions are held in both church and school, combining chat, group activities, a weekly challenge and cake! Family and friends are invited to the members' graduation as Happiness Ambassadors for the school and church community.

Claire Barber, Growing Faith Mission Enabler, has seen a very easy camaraderie bubble up: 'It's so special hearing the conversation and laughter – both adults and children said that before the club, they had no reason or opportunity to mix with people of a different generation, other than family. You can see how beneficial this is to both age groups.'

Ben Arnell, Head at St Andrew's CofE Primary says: 'Staff and parents are noticing a difference in the children's wellbeing and confidence, it's great to see

the two age groups share experiences and learn from each other, and our school/church link is flourishing.'
