

We heard from Andy Wolfe (Executive Director of Education, Church of England) about an exciting new development in the Growing Faith journey.

Andy reminded us that it's long been the desire of the Education Department that the partnership between church, school and household should be a really vibrant part of our theology, church and vision for our nation. Church of England schools make up over 20% of the UK education system - there are over a million children in our schools every day. Rather than simply desiring a closer partnership between church and school, we seek to see the creation of and resourcing of worshipping communities in schools and colleges - building where there is already that strength of community. This is a full partnership between the Education Department, Growing Faith Foundation, Vision and Strategy Team and Ministry team. Dioceses will be able to make proposals for funding for church growth particularly focused on CYP.

This significant piece of work (with a working title of "Flourish Network") is in its early stages and we would love Parachurch Organisations in our network to feel included, and to be able to to help shape this work, if they would like to. The underpinning principles are as follows:

- 1. Young people's voices are instinctively at the centre of all leadership decision-making and implementation
- 2. Clearly articulated and shared purpose to grow a younger and more diverse community of Christian disciples
- 3. Strategic leadership partnership between school/college and at least one church community (with appropriate long-term governance and resource commitment)
- 4. Intergenerational faith development experiences involving children and their families of all ages
- 5.Worship that is fully integrated into the regular rhythms, practices, structures and resources of the school/college's vision for flourishing of children and adults

We had some time in breakout rooms which resulted in robust questions, ideas and offers of support as well as high quality feedback which is going to be used to shape the wider thinking. We recognised that this piece of work is not something that every organisation in the network will want to be involved with, but that there is a significant core of people/organisations for whom this represents a significant passion or resonance with their role or their organisation's area of work.

Our next step is to organise an opportunity for interested parties to speak about this with the Education Office team in more detail, and you will be invited into this.
