Today we are making Messy Egg Biscuits


#### You will need:

- Plain round biscuits
- IcingSmall, hollow chocolate eggs
- Sprinkles



- Prepare the area for decorating biscuits and wash your hands.
   Break up the chocolate egg into large pieces with your hands.
   Spread icing on the biscuit.
   Then cover the biscuit with broken egg pieces and sprinkles. You are turning something messy into something beautiful!
   Enjoy eating your messy egg biscuits together.
   Top tip if you want to be even messier, use filled eggs!

#### Let's make


The Cheeky Pandas learn about Easter by hearing about five important moments in the Easter Story. Each of these moments could be represented by a different colour.

- 1. Palm Sunday: Green (for the palm leaves)
- 2. The Last Supper: Red (for the wine shared at the meal)
- 3. Good Friday: Brown (for the wooden cross)
- 4. Easter Saturday: Black (for the disciples waiting)
- 5. Easter Sunday: Yellow (for the sunrise on Easter Sunday morning, when the women found the empty tomb)

As a family gather as many different items from around the house or garden to represent the different colours of Easter and make them into a giant collage that tells the Easter Story. Take a photo of your collage to remember it before putting all the items back again!
