Right to seek leave to appeal against the Commissioners' decision

Any person who has duly made written representations about the draft Scheme may appeal to His Majesty in Council against the Scheme or any provisions of it, but only with the leave of the Judicial Committee of the Privy Council.

Any person who wishes to apply for leave to appeal to His Majesty in Council must first send notice of his or her intention to the Registrar of the Judicial Committee by email to: registry@jcpc.uk and copying to rex.andrew@churchofengland.org by **18 November 2024**.

The Registrar of the Judicial Committee has told us that the said Committee will accept requests for leave to appeal by email rather than by the usual postal service.

On being notified by the Registrar of the Judicial Committee of the receipt of the intention to apply for leave to appeal, the applicant will have a further 28 days to state the grounds of his or her appeal. The Registrar will provide details of the procedure to be followed.
