65th REPORT OF THE STANDING ORDERS COMMITTEE

Mr Clive Scowen (London) to move the following amendment to amendment 4 in the Annex to GS 2387:

'Leave out all the words after "vacant" and *insert* "the members of the House of Bishops from the Province with the vacant archiepiscopal see may make the nomination from among their own number".'

Explanatory statement: this amendment would change the effect of amendment 4 so that, where an archiepiscopal see is vacant, the members of the House of Bishops for the province including that see, rather than the other archbishop, are to have the power to nominate a deputy from among themselves.
